This document is a quick reference to the work as the class representative at the master's program Materials Chemistry.

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1. Introduction

The class representative at Materials Chemistry works as a link between the student division and your fellow students at the master's program.

As the class representative at Materials Chemistry you are a part of KUU, the student educational committee. One of the most important tasks for the committee is to monitor the education of the programs belonging to our student division, but the committee are also working with study-social questions. The most important tasks for the class representative is to listen and talk to your fellow students, keep track of the atmosphere within the classes and the courses at the program and to have a good contact with KUU so that the committee can help the students when needed. The committee knows who to talk to in order to raise certain questions or opinions, and by that affect those responsible for the education at Chalmers.

KUU arranges a short education for all the new class representatives so that you will be familiar with your role.

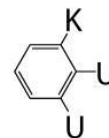
2. The work as class representative

- Let your fellow students know that you are the class representative and a contact person to KUU.
- Inform the course representatives that you are the class representative and a contact person to KUU.
- Attend the course evaluation meetings for the master's program and the meetings with the executive committee of chemical engineering (AUK). The invitations to these meetings are sent to you by KUU
- Attend the lunch meeting with KUU in study week 2-3 and 7 each study period and give the committee a short update of the situation at the program. You can of course come and talk to us any other time as well if you have any questions or issues you want to raise.
